
Each half term there will be a theme, which will either be Drop Everything and Read, Careers or PSHE. During Accelerate time.

- At the end of the first half-term all teachers will report whether your child has made a positive start or NOT made a positive start..
- In the Lent and Pentecost terms all teachers will report whether your child is making expected progress or NOT making expected progress.
