Students are encouraged to purchase a GCSE revision guide from our school shop. This will help students in preparation for end of unit assessments and homework practice assessment booklets in addition to the exams themselves. The existing GCSE syllabus is AQA Religious Studies B – Catholic Christianity with Judaism. **'Catholic Christianity'** is the first of two exam papers for GCSE. Each paper is **1 hour and 45-minutes** in duration. In Paper 1, Students will be tested on any **four** of the six units above. It is important that students prepare to answer questions from any of the six units.
