School Shoes and Trousers

Most school items are standard. Sometimes parents are presented with a very wide choice of shoes and trousers. Our advice is very specific.

This booklet shows examples of appropriate and inappropriate footwear and they are also displayed on the school website. Please check with your child's Head of Year if in doubt prior to purchase.

Shoes should be black polishable school shoes. They must be durable and protect the feet from potential accidents in classrooms, design and technology activities and around the school. Fashion items and training shoes or shoes which look like trainers are not appropriate school wear. Canvas shoes, sandals and boots are not permitted. **Shoes should be polishable. Shoes should not have any obvious logos.**

School trousers should be fitted to the waist and rest on the shoe. They can either be an elasticated waist or with a waist band. Please check with your child's Head of Year if in doubt prior to purchase.

Please note that a student who does not turn up to school in correct uniform may be withdrawn from class until the issue is sorted out.

These shoes comply with the uniform code and may be worn in school. Shoes shown are typical of the types of shoe which are acceptable. Parents are free to purchase from any supplier, no particular range or make of shoe is recommended.





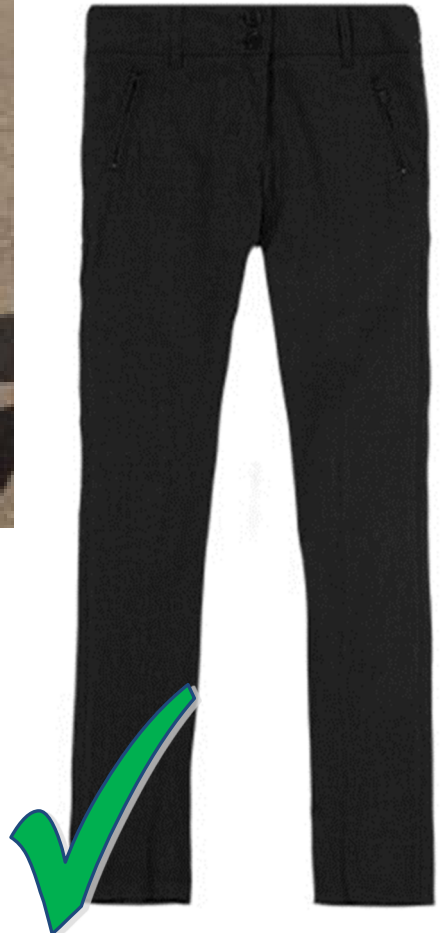
These shoes show the types of shoe which do not comply with the uniform code and may not be worn in school.
